- Has decreased sensation in left arm, wrist and fingers
- No response to neuropathic medication
- Neuro eval neg for CRPS


- +Night pain

- Allergies: NKDA




- Physical Exam:
 - 5'7", 227lbs (BMI 35)
 - Crepitus with shoulder ROM
 - Decreased sensation in M/R/U nerves compared to contralateral
 - ROM R L
 - FF: 160/150
 - ABD: 140/140
 - ERN: 60 / 60
 - IR: L1 / Sacrum
 - Special tests:
 - + Cross body abduction
 - + Hawkins
 - + Neer's
 - + Belly press
 - + Apprehension, relocation
 - Strength testing
 - Abd 4/5, ER 4/5, IR 4/5
